"LYX - LATEX WITHOUT THE PAIN"

Would you like to produce professional looking homework and papers, but don't really want to learn how to code? In this talk, I'll show you one option, known as LYX. It is a front end for classic LATEX, which allows you to see your writing in a more natural manner by seeing your work as math, instead of code. Of course, we will compare it to traditional TEX editors as well. Finally, if time permits we will dive into TikZ, a fairly capable drawing program for math that integrates with TEX, and therefore LYX as well.
